Criminal Investigation Division investigated the following incidents:

- 2023-October-2 – SC23008308 – Sudden Death – On October 2, 2023, the Uniform Division responded to an unresponsive person located in the dugout of the baseball diamond at 334 Metcalfe St West in Strathroy. The Criminal Investigations Division (CID) was assigned to investigate, which confirmed a male was deceased. The investigation determined that the death was not suspicious; the cause of death is under review by the Coroner.
- 2023-October-17 - SC23008716 – Theft and Recovery of Stolen Vehicle – On October 17, 2023, a Ford F350 pickup truck was stolen from the Mount Brydges Ford dealership on Glendon Drive. Neighboring police services were alerted to the theft; on October 21, 2023, the London Police reported that they had recovered the truck with two occupants inside. A male and a female from London were arrested and the vehicle was returned to Mount Brydges Ford.
- 2023-October-26 – SC23008781 – Search Warrant – Drugs – On October 26, 2023, CID Detectives sought and obtained a search warrant under the Controlled Drugs and Substances Act (CDSA) for a residence in Strathroy. The warrant was executed and a female was arrested. A quantity of Methamphetamine and cocaine was seized with an estimated street value of \$3,200. The female had previously been charged in July of 2023 with possession of a controlled substance for the purpose of trafficking and possession of proceeds of crime. She was on release for those charges when police conducted the search of her home and found more drugs; she remains in custody.
- October 2023 – The Street Crime Unit generated 19 reportable incidents in October. The incidents included impaired driving arrests, drug investigations, bail violations and focused patrols. The Street Crime Unit laid 9 charges in the month of July 2023.
