Criminal Investigation Division investigated the following incidents:

- 2024-February 2 SC24000505 Drugs/CDSA Search Warrant On January 22, 2024, members
 of the Criminal Investigations Division and the Street Crime Unit sought and obtained a warrant
 to search a residence in Strathroy for drugs. On February 2, 2024, that warrant was served and
 during the execution a male and a female were arrested. The subsequent search revealed a
 quantity of fentanyl, cocaine, methamphetamine and cash. The male and female face charges
 of possession of controlled substances for the purpose of trafficking.
- 2024-February 22 SC24001263 Sudden Death Strathroy-Caradoc PS CID members were summoned to a Strathroy senior living residence on the report of a sudden death. The Coroners Service requested that SCPS assist in the investigation of the deceased who died as a result of a fall, the investigation is ongoing.
- 2024 February 23 SC24001302 Sexual Assault CID Detectives were detailed to follow up
 on an earlier sexual assault complaint (SC24000292). The complainant wished to report to
 police that she had been sexually assaulted on other dates as well, this investigation is ongoing.
- 2024 February 24 SC24001333 Traffic Stop Members of the Street Crime Unit assisted by the Uniform Division conducted a traffic stop in Mount Brydges. As a result a male was arrested and a significant quantity of drugs were located. SCPS has charged a male with possession of controlled substances for the purpose of trafficking as well as other criminal code offences. The street value of the drugs seized as a result of this traffic stop was over \$5,000.
- Street Crime Unit (SCU) In February 2024, the SCPS SCU generated 19 reportable occurrences including drug investigations, impaired driving arrests, warrant executions and several stolen vehicle/trailer investigations (as part of the Provincial Auto Task Force Initiative).
- Digital Forensics Unit (DFU) In 2023, the SCPS DFU conducted examinations into 9 devices that
 were seized for investigation. The investment into the DFU system continues to be a very
 valuable tool for the police service.
