The Deputy Chief noted that he is waiting to receive more information about how they're rolling it out, the costs associated and the benefits to it, so hoping by the March meeting will have something in regards to and overview of what we may be looking at. Chief Campbell added that there is a role that Municipal Council will need to play as far as identifying community safety zones or school safety zones. The Chief also believes that the Traffic Committee is having further discussion on this.

Councillor Brennan commented on the efficiency of the meeting and thinks the

Board is moving in a positive and constructive direction and is looking forward to the next year.
