Criminal Investigation Division investigated the following incidents:

- 2024-May-8 SC24003455 Break and Enter CID members were tasked to assist the Uniform Division with a break and enter to a commercial property in Zone 2. The investigation revealed that suspects cut a hole in a fence to gain access and stole a quantity of copper wiring. Officers are working with the corporate security team for the business to identify the suspects.
- 2024-May-15 SC24003581 Sexual Assault/Luring CID members were assigned to investigate the
 complaint of a sexual assault on a young person. The investigation revealed that a young female may
 have been lured by an adult male to meet in a local motel where the assault took place. Police are
 investigating and believe that the adult male has travelled to Strathroy from another jurisdiction. The
 investigation is ongoing.
- 2024 May 27 SC24004049 Weapons- A uniformed officer conducted a traffic stop in the east end of Strathroy for speeding. The officer found that the driver was wanted by the OPP, and was subsequently arrested. During the search incident to arrest, the officer located a loaded Glock 9mm pistol with an over capacity magazine. The male has been charged with seven firearms related offences and two Highway Traffic Act offences. CID and Forensic Ident has now been tasked to process the firearm and complete the investigation.
- Street Crime Unit (SCU) In May 2024, 37 reportable occurrences were generated including but not limited to; drug investigations, focused patrols, foot patrols, shoplifting incidents and vehicle thefts. Of note, SCU was instrumental in identifying a group of transient people who are involved in a significant theft ring in southern Ontario. SCU is has also been very busy with the Provincial Auto Theft network, providing intelligence to the Joint Force Operation.
- Digital Forensics Unit (DFU) In May 2024, the DFU has been steady and continuing to extract data from devices and provide reports to investigating officers.
