Criminal Investigation Division investigated the following incidents:

- 2024-June -2 - SC24004259 – Drug Trafficking/Weapons – CID members were tasked to assist the Uniform Division with an investigation into a male who had been called in as an unwanted person in Melbourne. When the male was arrested, a large cache of weapons were located as well as a quantity of drugs. The male was charged with possession for the purpose of trafficking and possession of weapons dangerous to the public peace.
- 2024-June-5 - SC24004355 – Theft/Dangerous Driving/Assault with a Weapon – CID members were assigned to assist the Uniform Division with an occurrence at a local business. When security tried to stop the male and female pair from shoplifting, the suspects drove a vehicle at the store employee striking them, then fled at a high rate of speed. With the assistance of the London Police and the OPP, an adult male and an adult female have been located and charged accordingly. The store employee suffered minor physical injuries.
- 2024 – June – SC24004334/5080 – Frauds – CID continues to get reassigned multiple fraud occurrences for review and or investigation. It is a common occurrence for citizens to be defrauded by various means. CID members along with our Media Relations Officer continue to try and educate the public about potential scams so that we can try to reduce the victimization.
- 2024 – June -21 - SC24005043 – Theft/Fraud Over \$5000 – A male suspect from out of our region attended an address in Strathroy and produced a fraudulent bank draft for the sum of \$27,500. The suspect and the victim had been chatting via Facebook Marketplace Messenger and agreed to the purchase and sale of a side by side ATV and trailer. The seller fell victim to the fraud and his property was taken by the suspect. CID has been liaising with Toronto Police in hopes that we may recover the property and charge the suspect. Investigation ongoing.
- Street Crime Unit (SCU) – SCU generated 16 reportable occurrences including but not limited to; Thefts, Possession of Stolen Property, Liquor License Act investigations and focused patrols.
- Digital Forensics Unit (DFU) – DFU has been steady and continuing to extract data from devices and provide reports to investigating officers.
