- Cst. MCINTYRE is working alongside CMHA MCRT workers Monday to Friday. MCRT is conducting follow ups daily as well as attending calls involving Mental Health.
- Number of MCRT live calls/follow ups completed: **66**
- Total individuals supported: **89**
- MCRT resolved at scene/hospital diversion: **4**, MCRT apprehension: **1** MCRT Voluntary Transport: **3**
- Cst. MCINTYRE is the RTD Database entry administrator for the Situation Table, which meets weekly. We had **1** situations this month.

MEDIA:
