Criminal Investigation Division investigated the following incidents:

- 2024-July-04 - SC24005289 – Child Pornography Investigation – CID members took over an investigation from the Uniform Division where an allegation was made that inappropriate images of a young person were being distributed online. CID members isolated the images and have seized electronic devices for examination by the Digital Forensics Unit. This investigation is ongoing.
- 2024-July-10 - SC24005481 – Theft / Firearms Offences – CID members embarked on an investigation into possible stolen firearms that were unlawfully stored in a Strathroy residence. CID and SCU sought and obtained a search warrant for the residence and during the search, several firearms were located illegally stored. Some of the firearms were proven to be stolen. A Strathroy man has been charged with 8 criminal code and firearms offences and will attend London Court later in August.
- 2024-July-10 - SC24005494 – Sexual Assault – SCPS Uniform Division members were detailed to investigate a missing person/human trafficking occurrence. Officers realized that this investigation was multi-jurisdictional and the case was reassigned to CID. CID members liaised with the London Police Sexual Assault and Human Trafficking unit and assisted them with their investigation as a significant portion of it occurred in Strathroy-Caradoc. As a result of the investigation, two young persons have been removed from harm and police have suspects to investigate.
- SC24005908/SC24005943/SC24006127 – Break and Enters – During the month of July, SCPS CID has been assigned to investigate 3 separate and unrelated break and enter occurrences. Two of the occurrences occurred in commercial buildings. In one of the occurrences, an adult male was identified and has been arrested and taken into custody.
- Street Crime Unit (SCU) – In July 2024, the Street Crime Unit was very busy generating 49 reportable occurrences. SCU conducted and participated in weapons investigations, stolen vehicle investigations, indecent acts, gang related occurrences as well as several focused patrols and traffic related investigations.
- Digital Forensics Unit (DFU) – In July 2024, the DFU has been steady and continuing to extract data from devices and provide reports to investigating officers. D/C Butts has also been busy with training programs that are being offered by vendors of the software.
