Criminal Investigation Division investigated the following incidents:

- 2024- November 1 - SC24008811 – Sexual Assault – CID members were requested to assist London and Middlesex Children’s Aid Society on the report of a sexual assault. CID did investigate and an adult male was charged with sexual assault and sexual interference on a young person.
- 2024-November 7 and November 11, 2024 - SC2408940 and SC24009063 – Sudden Deaths – CID Detectives attended to two separate sudden deaths in the Municipality. CID members acted in a supporting role for the Uniform Division Officers to ensure that the deaths were not suspicious in nature.
- 2024-November 11 – SC2409079 – Sexual Assault - CID members were notified by the Lambton County OPP of a sexual assault that had occurred in Strathroy-Caradoc. CID commenced an investigation which led to an adult male being charged with sexual assault against an adult female.
- 2024 – November 27 – SC24009492 – Sexual Assault – London Police Service requested the assistance of SCPS CID in a sexual assault investigation. SCPS Detectives conducted interviews and it was determined that there was insufficient evidence to proceed with criminal charges as a result of the investigation.
- 2024 – November 27 – SC24009507- Missing Person – SCPS received a report of a missing person. The investigation revealed that the male was considered a vulnerable person and had not been seen in over a week. CID assisted in the investigation and utilized social media platforms to alert the public. Shortly after a media release, police received information as to the male’s whereabouts and he was located safe.
- Street Crime Unit (SCU) – In November 2024, the Street Crime Unit generated 39 reportable occurrences. Of note, on November 21, 2024, SCU along with members from CID, SCPS Uniform Division and members of the Sarnia Police Service Emergency Response Team and K9 Unit executed a search warrant under the Controlled Drugs and Substances Act on Head St N. As a result of that search, a female was charged with several offences. Police recovered 147 grams of cocaine worth nearly \$15,000, 275 grams of illicit cannabis worth \$4129, and \$75,000 in stolen jewelry.
- Digital Forensics Unit (DFU) – In November 2024, the DFU has been steady and continuing to extract data from devices and provide reports to investigating officers. Detective Constable Butts is currently undergoing more extensive training on the software.
