

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF STRATHROY-CARADOC

BY-LAW NO. 24-25

**A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT FOR
THE OPERATION OF THE MOUNT BRYDGES AND STRATHROY
WASTE TRANSFER STATIONS (SARNIA PAVING STONE)**

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, Section 5(1), as amended, provides that the powers of a municipal corporation are to be exercised by its council;

AND WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, Section 9, as amended, provides for a municipality to enter into agreements;

AND WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, Section 5(3), as amended, provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity rights, powers and privileges under Section 9; shall be exercised by By-Law;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Strathroy-Caradoc approved, by resolution, the awarding of the contract for Waste Transfer Station Operations to Sarnia Paving Stone on January 20, 2025;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it expedient to enter into an Agreement with the Sarnia Paving Stone for the operation of the Mount Brydges and Strathroy Waste Transfer Stations for the period of March 1, 2025 to February 28, 2030;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF STRATHROY-CARADOC AS FOLLOWS:

1. **THAT:** The Mayor and Clerk be hereby authorized to execute an Agreement between the Municipality of Strathroy-Caradoc and Sarnia Paving Stone for the operations of the Mount Brydges and Strathroy Waste Transfer Stations.
2. **THAT:** this by-law come into force and take effect on the date of its final passage in Open Council.

Read a FIRST and SECOND and THIRD time and FINALLY PASSED in Open Council this 18th day of February, 2025.
