5. Reports

5.1 Curator's Report: September - October - CS-2024-53

Michelle Wright, Museum Curator presents the Curator's Report for September- October. She shares with the committee that the Middlesex Heritage Trail will be updating heritage signs throughout the community, Mount Brydges, South Caradoc, and Melbourne, signs to go up in the Spring and Strathroy signs will follow. The Poppy Project was successful and there will be more events as there are more poppies to attach. Over 9700 poppies have been donated. She also provided an update on the Collections Database - PastPerfect and as of October 31st 2024, 1149 records have been updated. This includes adding new records, images, and locations as well as new information to existing records.

Michelle Wright indicates that there are currently 5 volunteers that are working on Collections, Exhibition, and Programming related activities. Projects include database management, rehousing artifacts, exhibit creation, markets, etc. Total hours accumulated up to October 31st is 520. The Poppy Project saw approximately 100 people over the course of 6 days (estimating 300-400 hours total) attach poppies to the netting.
