SUBJECT: Master Fire Plan and Fire Hall Location Study

RECOMMENDATION: THAT: Council receive and action the Master Fire Plan and Fire Hall Location Study as suggested in the recommendations and timelines.

BACKGROUND:

In January of 2021, the Municipality authorized that a Master Fire Plan and a component of the official plan for a fire hall location study be put out in RFP.

The study was completed in draft form in May 2021, after interview, questionnaires and surveys of council members, staff, firefighters and the public. The final plans were completed in July and have been circulated to senior staff and council for knowledge and comment.
